SASH08 Ancient Greece and Its Neighbors Due in class 13 October 2010

- Write an essay of 3 full text pages <u>plus</u> bibliography and footnotes, using all course literature
- Start with an introduction where you present the question and your approach to the answer. Be sure to read the question all of it thoroughly
- The aim is to be analytical, not descriptive the descriptive part is the use of evidence to back up your statements and viewpoints
- End with discussion, your ideas and conclusions.

Question

Looking at the total picture of especially the Aegean, but even the Wider Sphere, in the LBA, we see a fairly rigid international economic system, run by the various elites and rulers for their own benefit, tho' in different ways. Using all of the Aegean regions, give your idea of the continued development after 1200 if the events of c. 1200 had NOT taken place. To do this, you must consider and trace briefly the developments, even (briefly) in the Wider Sphere, during the period, the motivations behind them, their results, all other factors (ecology, natural catastrophe, etc. etc.) in the period 1600 – 1200, the LBA up to the destructions.

Guidelines:

- Use 11- or 12-point script, such as Times; write with 1 1/2-line spacing and normal margins.
- Your course literature is your primary source material, although you may use additional sources if you wish. <u>All relevant course literature must be used</u>.
- Use footnotes (stating author, year and page) and add a bibliography of the literature you have used at the end, even for course literature. You may use any reference system you want but you must be consistent. Keep in mind that if you use the web as a source, you must give the URL in full as well as the date you accessed it. All the relevant course literature must be included. Better too many than too few footnotes!
- Remember that plagiarism from any source is against the law and must be reported to the Discipline Board. Plagiarism is using someone else's information/pictures without giving a reference. This also includes information from the web.
