

SASH19 The Dynamics of Interaction

Paper assignment, spring 2012

Write two essays, one on each of the topics below, of minimum 3, maximum 4 pages each (including references, but not including bibliography).

1. The socio-economic interaction between the Greeks and the populations of Italy from the 8th century BC to c. 500 BC: Discuss and exemplify how this interaction contributed to the development of Etruscan culture.
2. How did the Roman conquest affect the Celtic and Roman cultures in North-Western Europe with regard to social organization, language and material culture? Concentrate on a few examples and discuss this question in terms of both continuity and change.

Guidelines:

An academic essay should synthesize the information gained from sources and weave them into a well ordered discourse, using the sources as evidence to support key points. A significant part of the essay should be your own analysis and interpretation of the subject at hand, not merely a description of it.

- Use 12-point script and write with 1,5-line spacing and normal margins. Don't forget pagination and respect the recommended length of the essays.
- Your course literature is your primary source material, although you may use *additional* sources if you wish. **All relevant course literature must be used.**
- Include references (stating author, year and page) in the text and add a bibliography of the literature you have used at the end, even for course literature. Better too many than too few references! You may use any reference system you want but you must be consistent. Keep in mind that if you use the web as a source, you must give the URL in full as well as the date you accessed it. More information on writing and citing may be found in the *subject guide* on the course web.
- Remember that plagiarism from any source is against the law and must be reported to the Discipline Board. Plagiarism is using someone else's information/pictures without giving a reference. This also applies to information from the web.
- Your essays should be submitted by e-mail as two separate files in .doc format to Fredrik.Ekengren@ark.lu.se . The deadline is May 10, no later than 10.30 pm.
